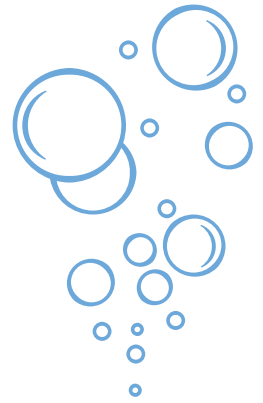

stabilises and prevents rolling



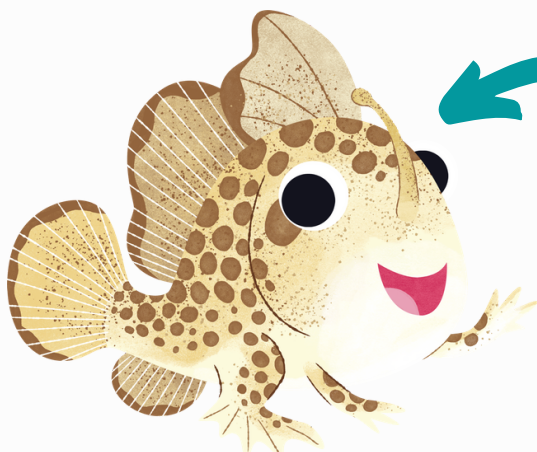
Tail
